Strong net income growth in the first nine months of 2020

- We continue to prioritise the health and safety of our employees, while supporting our partners and communities
- Net sales up 10.3% vs PY¹ in 9M, over proportionate recurring EBIT up 15.7% vs PY¹ in 9M
- Net sales up 31.4% vs PY¹ in Q3
- Recurring EBIT up 7.2% vs PY¹ in Q3, despite significant Naira devaluation
- Robust free cash flow generation of N50,6bn (+94.5% vs PY¹ in 9M) and strengthened balance sheet
