Q3 AND 9M 2019 HIGHLIGHTS

Q3 2019 revenue down 25,1% to N53,9 bn Q3 2019 revenue in Nigeria at N45,2 bn (-7,2% vs LY) South Africa revenue in July 2019 closing at N8,7 bn EBITDA (pre-IFRS 16) up 32,7% to N11,4 bn in Q3 2019, supported by the implementation of efficiency & cost reduction strategy Nigeria: EBITDA of N11,6 bn, (+12,1% vs LY) and EBITDA margin of 25,7% (post-IFRS EBITDA margin of 32,7%) South Africa: EBITDA in July 2019 at negative N0.2 bn Operating profit (EBIT) multiplied by 2,7x in Q3 Significant finance costs improvement (-70,6% vs LY) Positive net income for four consecutive quarters Successful divestment from Lafarge South Africa Holdings, further deleveraging Lafarge

Q3 2019 includes SA's one month numbers versus three months in prior year while 9M 2019 includes SA's seven months number versus nine months in the prior year



- Net sales down 25,1% in Q3, mainly attributable to volume decline
- > Strong EBITDA growth in Q3 (+32,7% vs LY), supported by the implementation of efficiency and cost reduction strategy
- Operating profit multiplied by 2,7x in Q3
- > Significant finance cost improvement in Q3 2019 (-70,6% vs LY)

- ▶ Q3 2019 net sales at N45,2 bn (-7,2% vs LY), largely affected by volume decline attributable to heavy rains
- > Strong EBITDA growth (+12,1% vs LY), supported by the implementation of efficiency and cost reduction strategy
- ➤ Significant finance cost improvement in Q3 2019 (-70,3% vs LY), attributable to repayment of all short-term loans and USD293 million loan from proceeds of Rights Issue and divestment from Lafarge South Africa respectively
- ▶ Gain on disposal of Investment in Subsidiary impacting Profit After Tax by N106,5 bn
