	6-12 months from date of production if stored properly in original unopened, sealed and undamaged packaging in cool and dry conditions at temperatures between +15°C and +35°C. Protect from direct sunlight and humidity.

Application	<b>Consumption / Dosage</b> A bag of Supafix (20kg) can cover a minimum of 5m <sup>2</sup> (approximately 32 of 40x40 tiles) on a well plumb substrates surface.
	Substrate Preparation The substrate must be structurally sound and free from all traces of loose material, laitance, oil and grease. Substrates must be saturated surface dry (no standing water).
	<b>Mixing</b> Add just 6 – 7 liters of water to one bag of Supafix C2 (20kg), then mix properly till you get a consistent mixture. Using your hand trowel, take a portion of the mixture and turn upside down. If it remains on the trowel, then the consistency of the mixture is ok.
	<b>Supafix Application</b> Apply Supafix Tile Adhesive on the substrate using a notched trowel in order to achieve a minimum uniform thickness. Press firmly the tile into the substrate for a few seconds to ensure good contact with the adhesive. The notch trowel comes in 6mm, 8mm, 10mm size depending on the size of tiles you have.
