GYPSUM PLASTER (PLASTER OF PARIS - PoP)

Product Description

Lafarge Supawhyte is a Plaster of Paris produced by calcining only natural gypsum in accordance to BS EN 13279-1.

Lafarge Supawhyte Gypsum Plaster (PoP) is classified as C1 suitable for fibrous plaster works.

Composition

Lafarge Supawhyte PoP is produced entirely from calcined natural gypsum and does not contain any harmful or hazardous chemicals hence inherently non emitting source of volatile organic compounds (VOCs). It also does not contain any binders or other ingredients that include organic chemicals.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

Clean tools and molds thoroughly to remove any residue from previous uses. Add Lafarge Supawhyte PoP to water and let it soak for one minute. Stir the mixture continuously, either by hand or with an electric mixer, until it becomes smooth and consistent. Pour the mixture into the mold and work with it for 8 minutes before it begins to set. The plaster will fully set in approximately 22 minutes. The mixing method and environmental factors can affect the setting time.

Handling and Storage

Keep out of reach of children! Do not take internally. Use only with adequate ventilation. Ensure fresh air entry during application and drying. Do not breathe dust. Removal of this product after use will result in the generation of Dust. If dry-sanded, exposure to dust may result in the build-up of material in eyes, ears, nose, and mouth which may cause irritation. To be stored properly in original unopened, sealed and undamaged packaging in cool and dry conditions at temperatures between +15°C and +35°C. Protect from direct sunlight and humidity.

b: After conditioning for 2 hours after the final setting time under the conditions specified

c: After conditioning for 7 days in a humid atmosphere (20 ± 2) °C and (95 ± 5) % of relative humidity, followed by drying to constant mass at (40 ± 2) °C.
